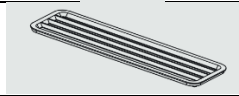
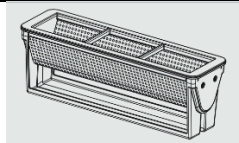
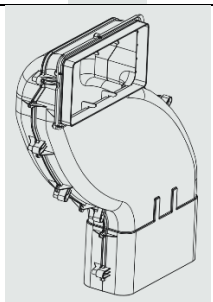
PRODUCT INSTALLATION

Installation notes

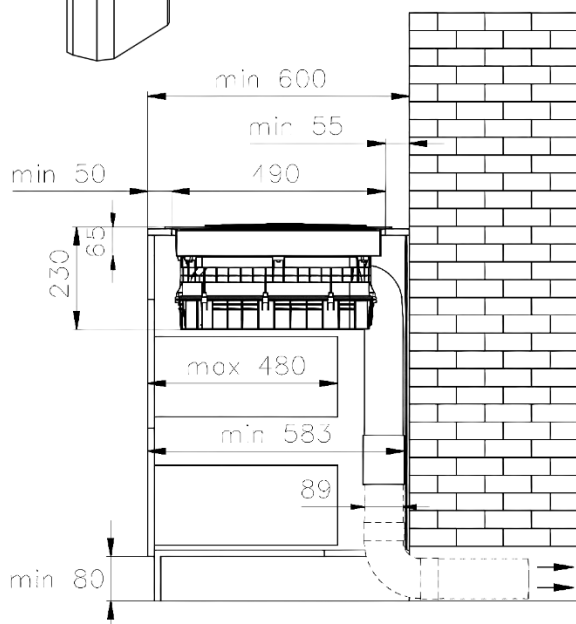
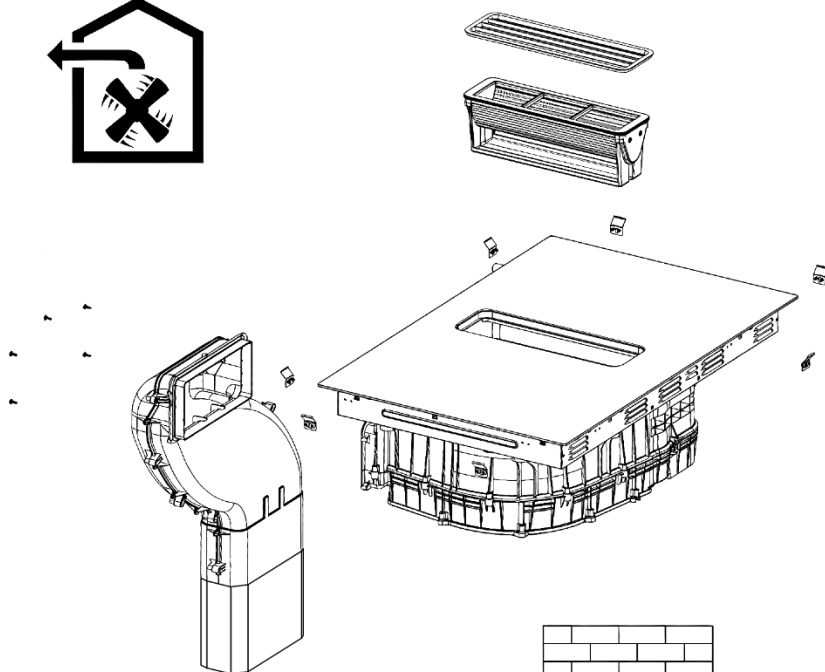
- The appliance must be installed by qualified professionals.
- Installation or maintenance must only be carried out by qualified technicians in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and applicable local safety regulations. No repairs or replacement of parts must be carried out unless specifically stated in the user manual.
- When the installation is completed, the electrical components must be inaccessible to the user.
- Before connecting the appliance to the power supply, check the rating plate (on the underside of the appliance) to ensure that the voltage and power rating are compatible with the power supply and that the connection point is suitable.
- The appliance must be connected to a fixed installation fitted with a multi-pole switch that ensures the power supply can be completely cut off.
- Incorrect installation may invalidate the warranty and liability.
- The components supplied must be used to ensure optimum performance. If the air ducts are altered or extended, this may affect the performance of the hood.
- When servicing or repairing the appliance, ensure that both the hood and the ducts are easily accessible.



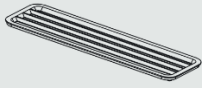
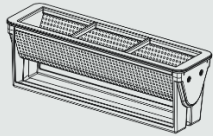
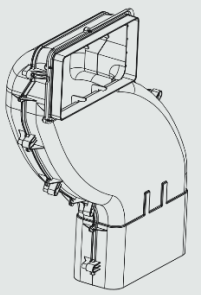
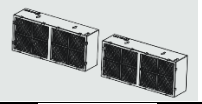
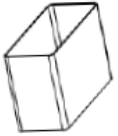

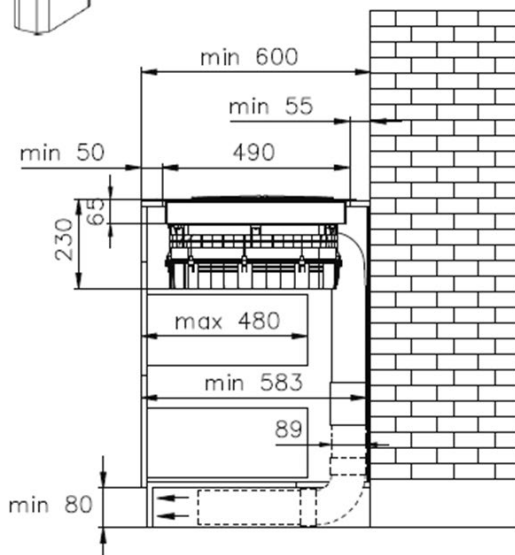
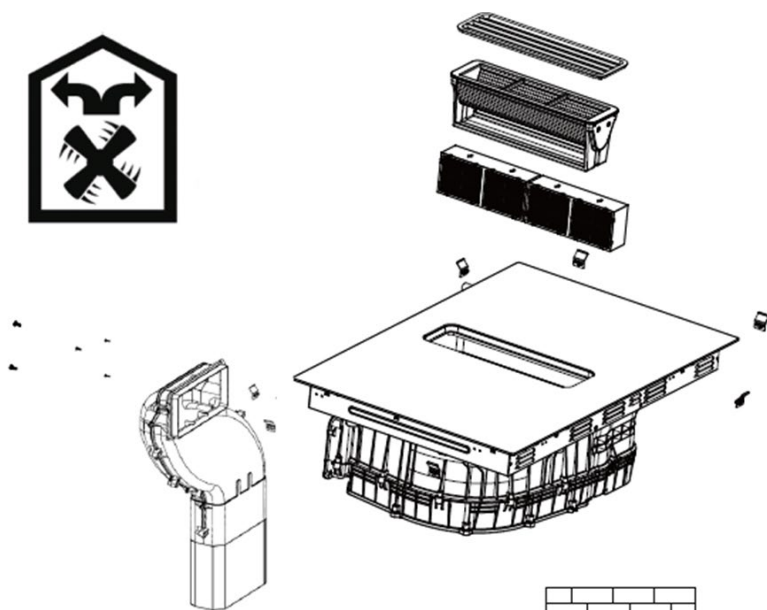
Extractor fan operation

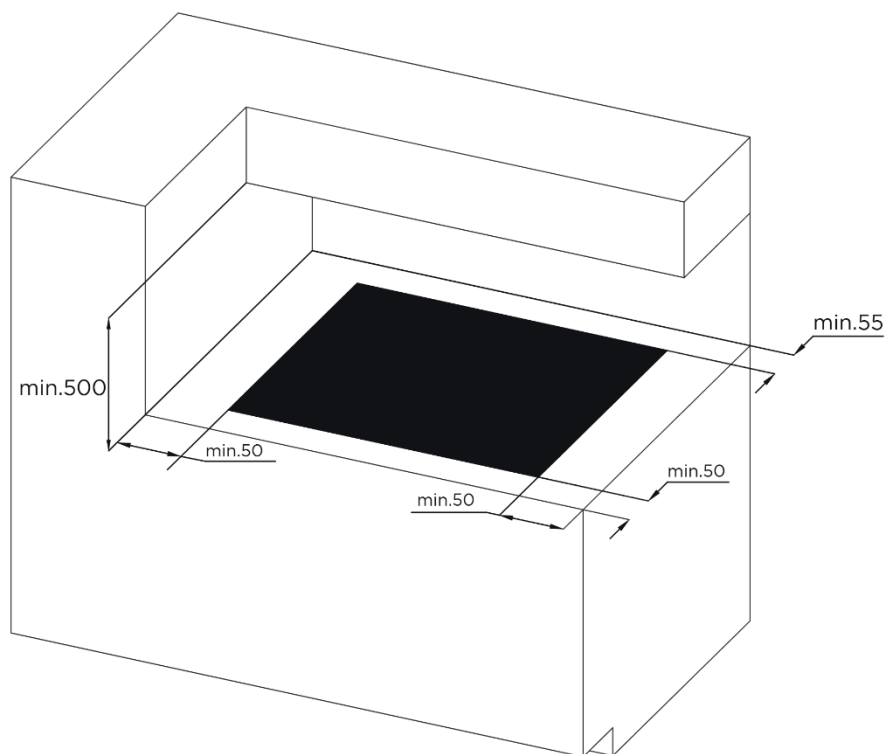

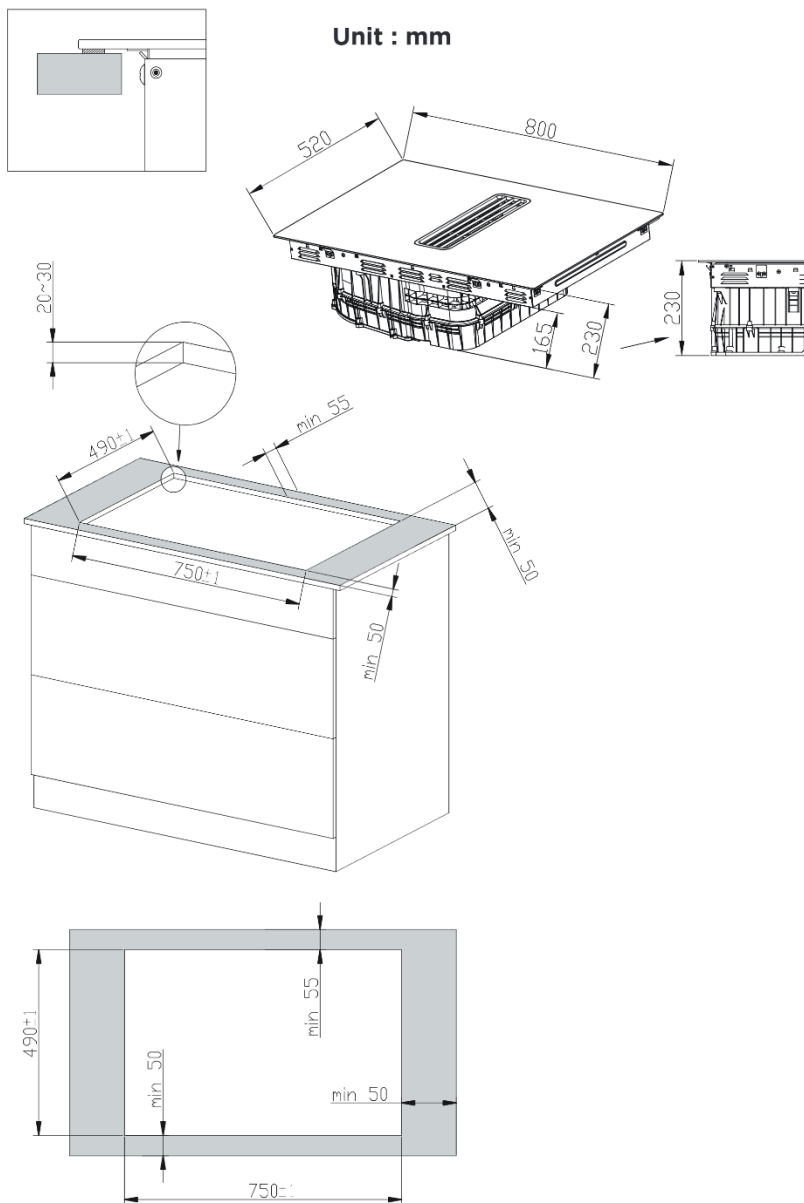


Installation dimensions

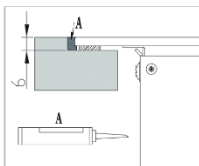

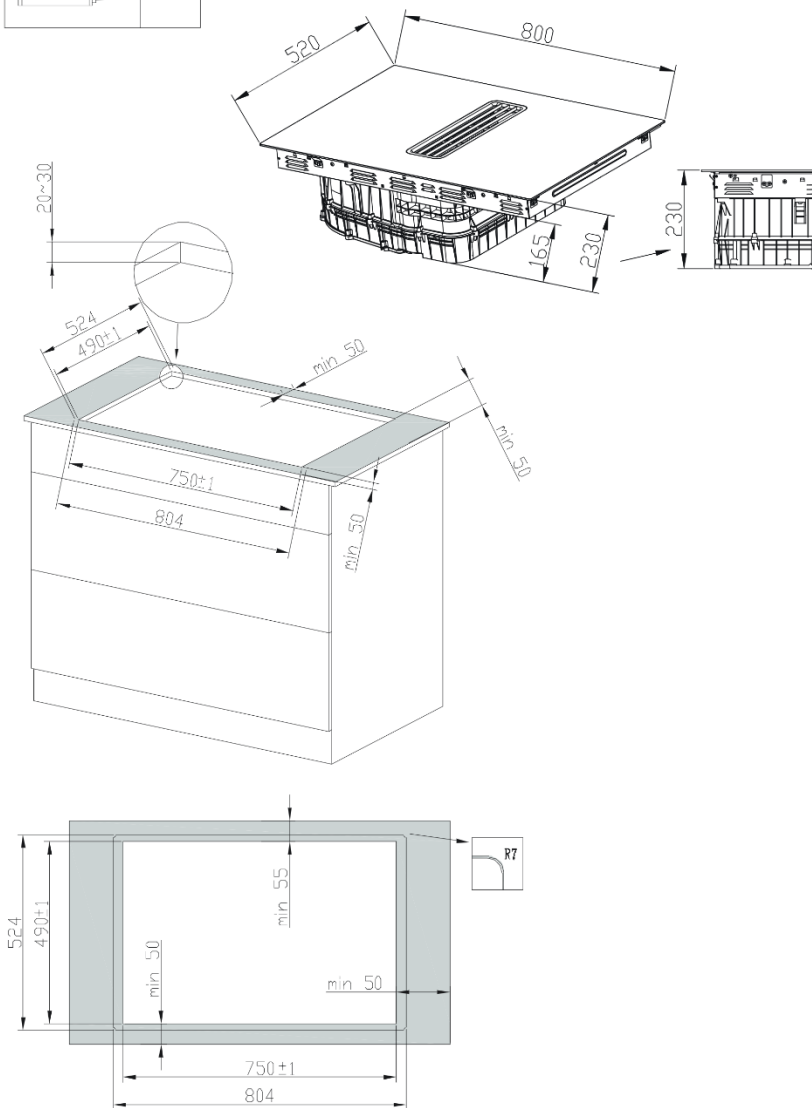
Flat - mounting

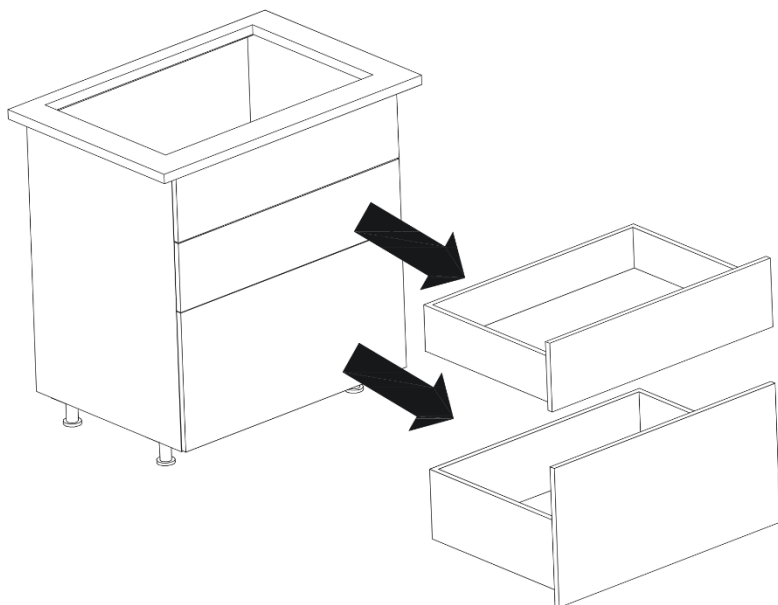


Flat - gluing

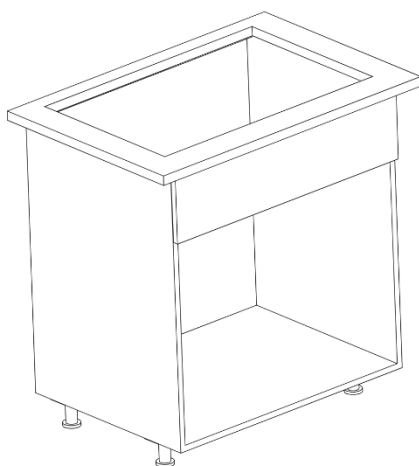

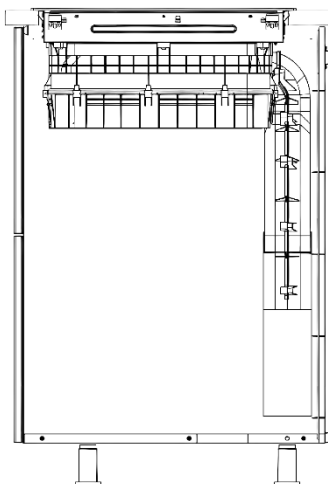
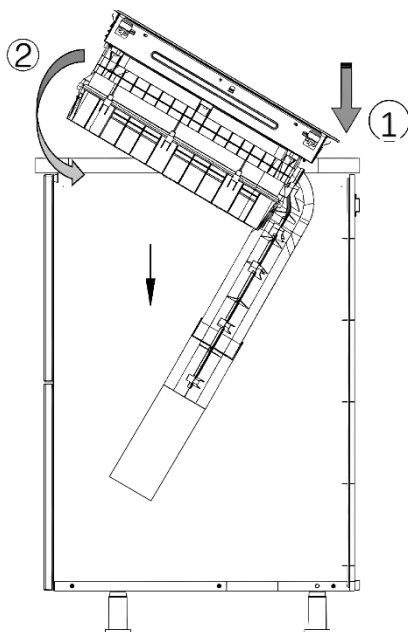


Installation of an exhaust duct

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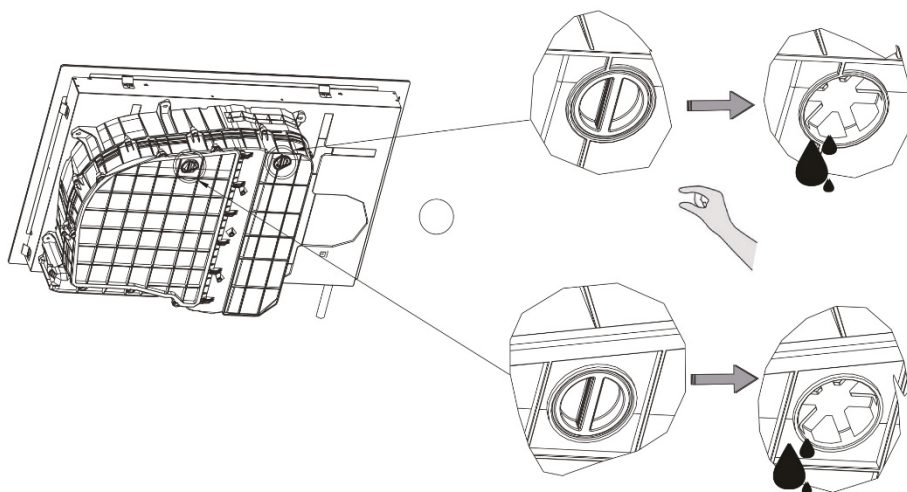

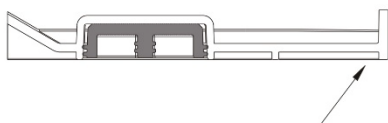


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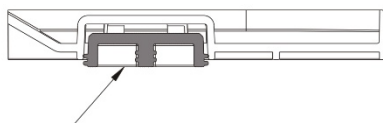

into place

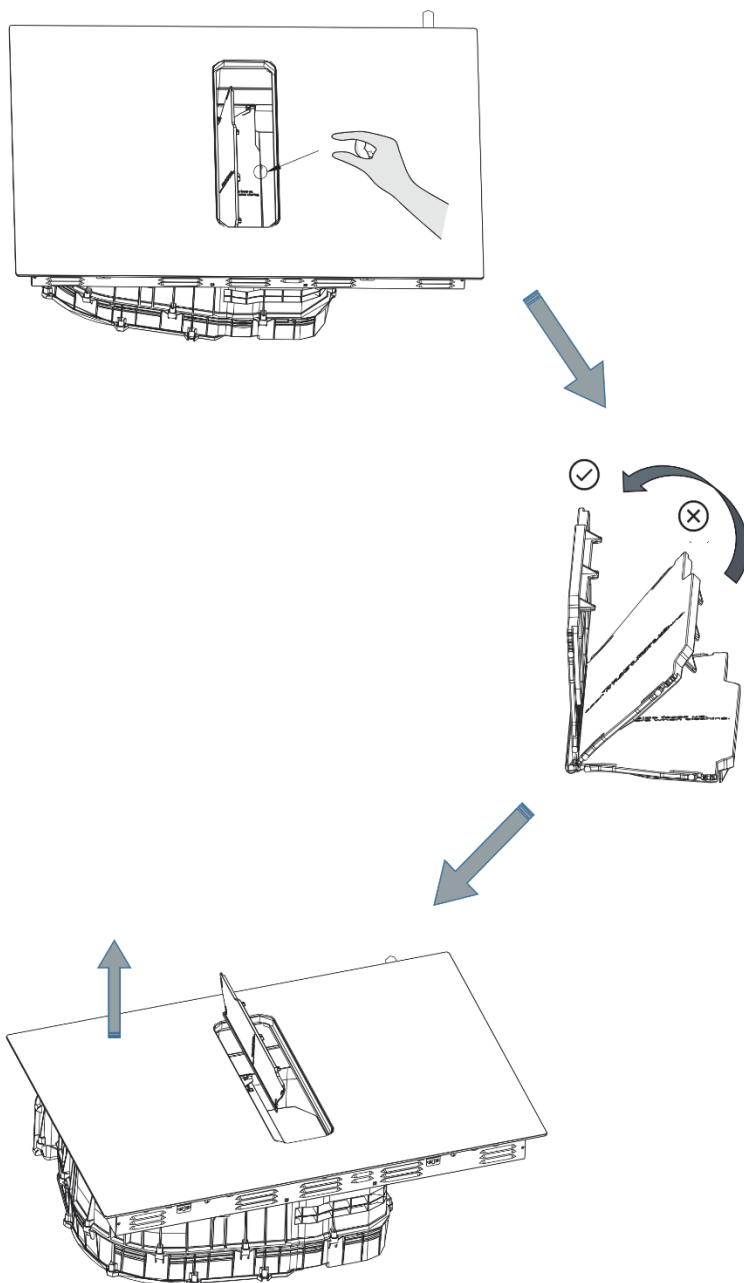


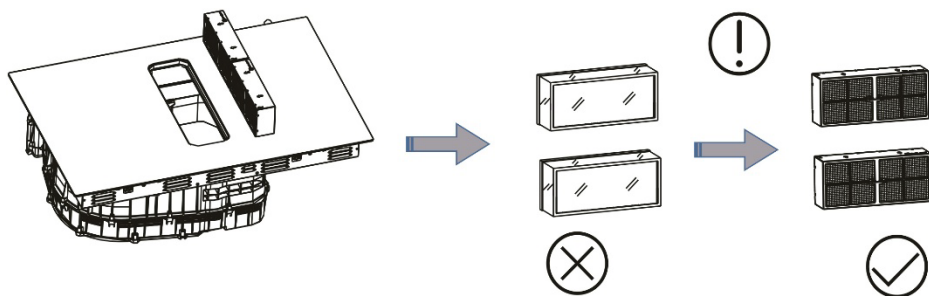
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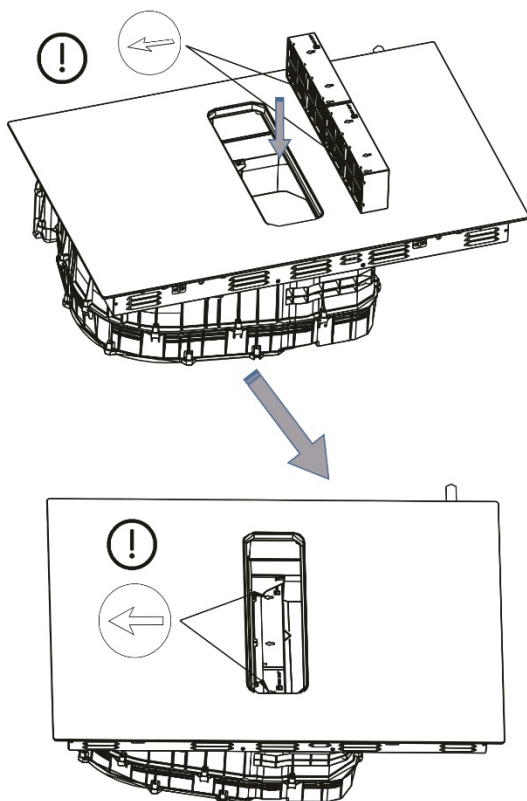

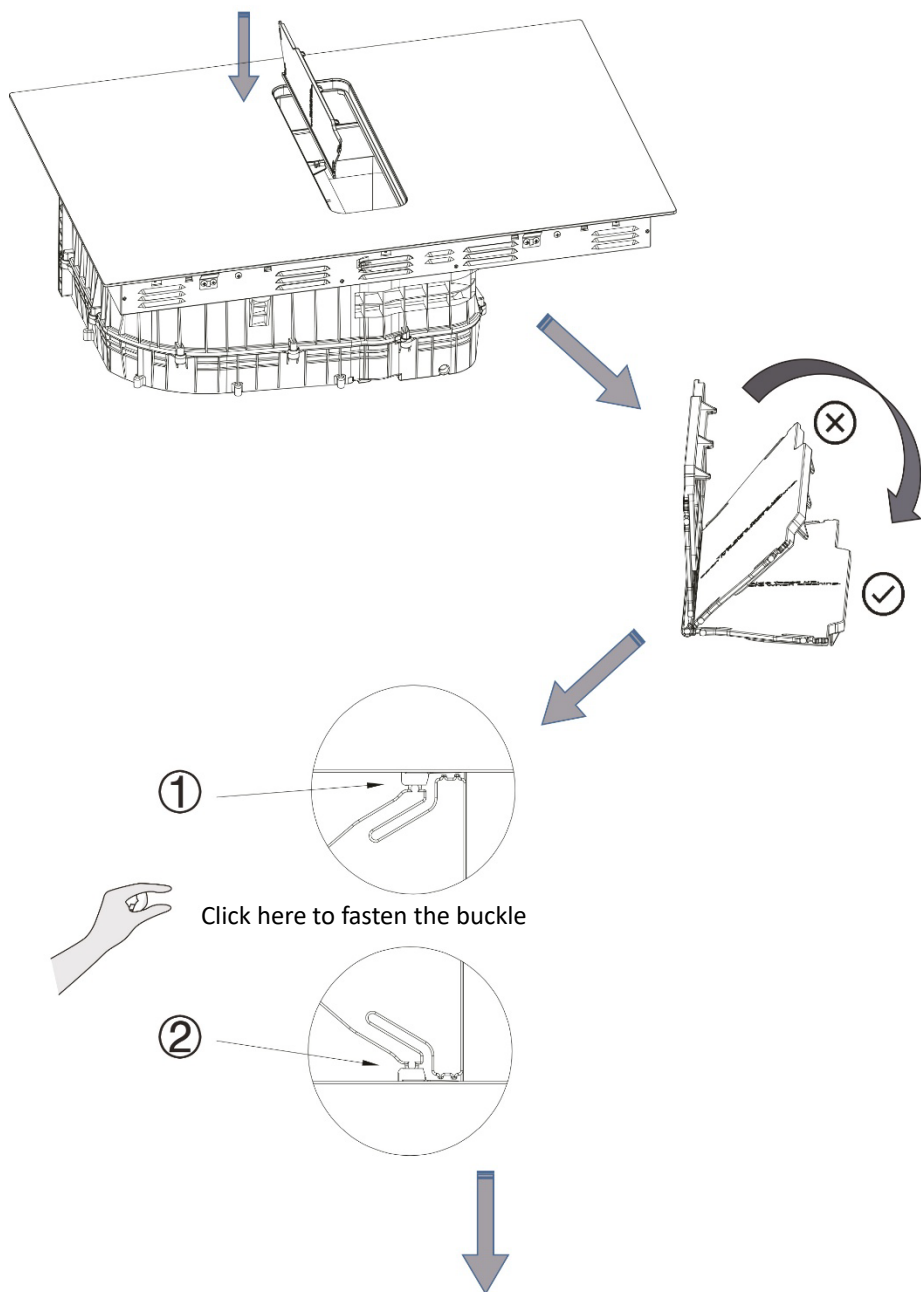
Precautions when installing a carbon filter (cube type)

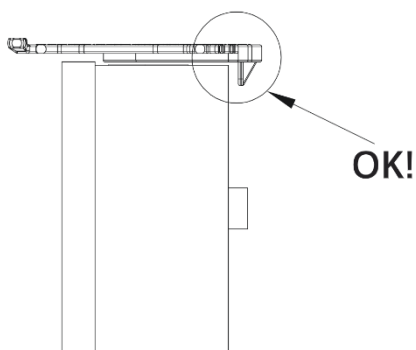
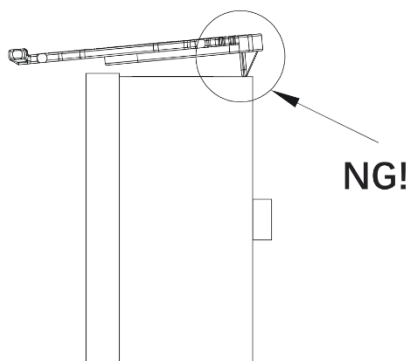
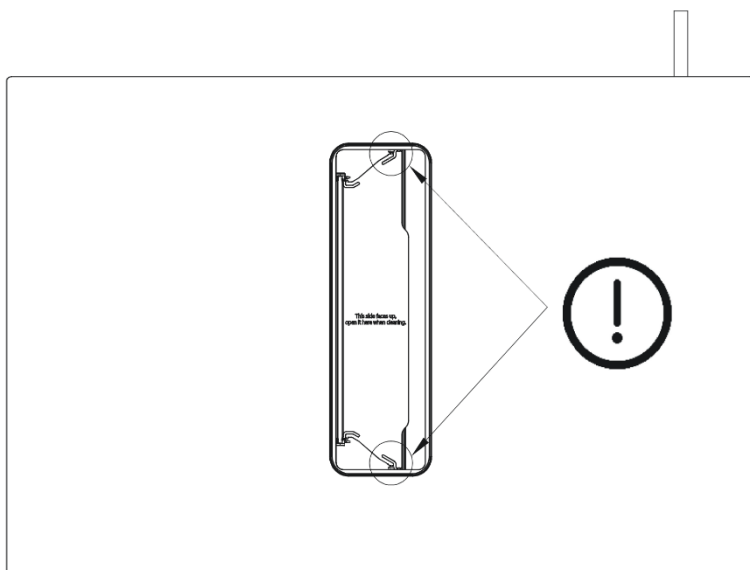


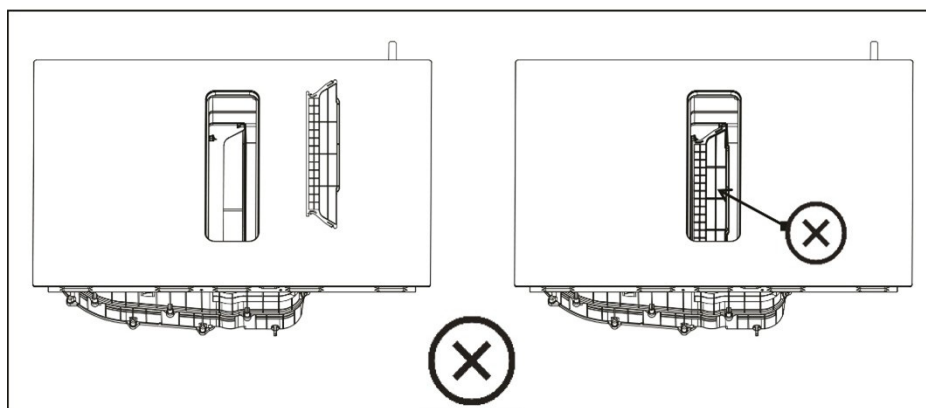
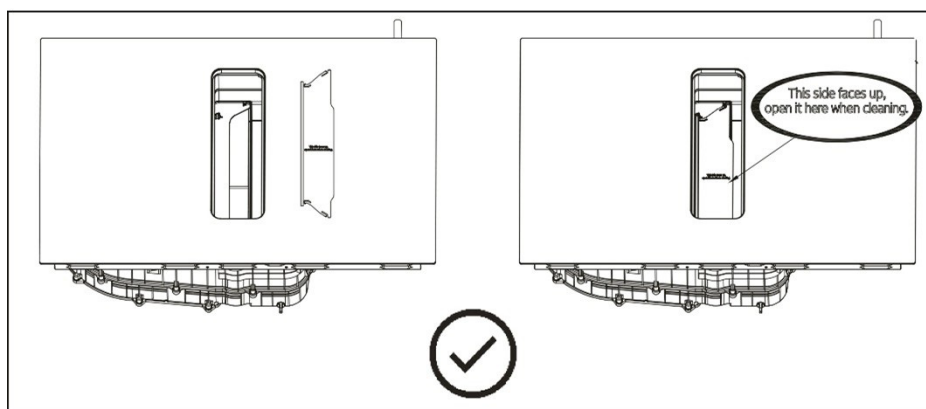
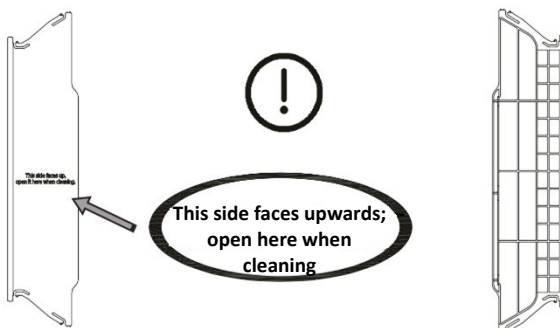


Remove the outer, transparent film from the carbon filters before use







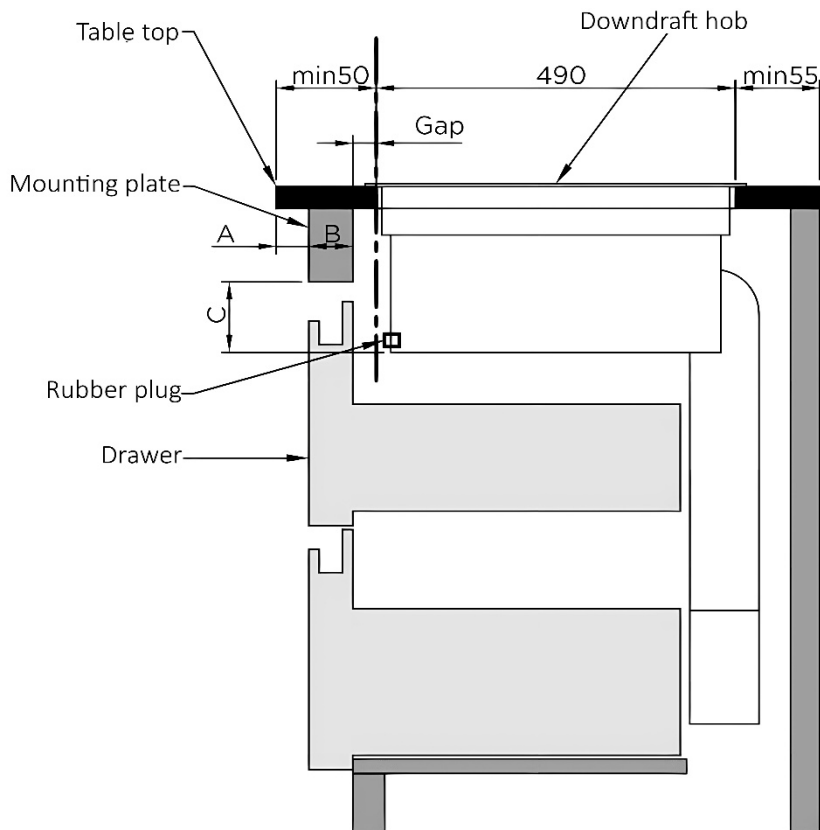


WARNING: Ensure there is adequate ventilation

To ensure that liquids can drain away easily, it is recommended that a minimum clearance of 40 mm be maintained between the partition plate and the underside of the appliance. Please observe the requirements below:

Requirement 1: Distance = $50 - A - B > 5 \text{ mm}$

Requirement 2: $C > 40 \text{ mm}$ for easy removal of the rubber plug



 There are ventilation openings along the outside of the appliance. Make sure that these openings are not blocked by the worktop when installing the appliance.

 Please note that the adhesive used to join plastic parts with wooden components in the furniture must be able to withstand temperatures of at least 150 °C to prevent the finish from peeling.



The rear wall, adjacent components and surrounding surfaces must therefore be able to withstand temperatures of up to 90 °C.

IMPORTANT

1. The appliance must only be installed by qualified professionals or authorised technicians. Installation must not be carried out by the user.
2. The appliance must not be installed directly on top of a dishwasher, refrigerator, freezer, washing machine or dryer as the moisture may damage the electronic components of the appliance.
3. The appliance must be installed in such a way as to ensure adequate heat dissipation in order to maintain optimum operational reliability.
4. The wall and the area above the appliance must be able to withstand heat.
5. To prevent damage, the worktop's layered construction and adhesive must be able to withstand heat.
6. Do not use a steam cleaner.

Connecting the appliance to the power supply



The appliance must only be connected to the power supply by a qualified professional.

Before connecting, check the following:

1. The property's electrical installation is suitable for the appliance's power consumption.
2. That the voltage corresponds to the value stated on the type plate.
3. The power cable is of sufficient capacity for the load specified on the type plate.

When connecting to the power supply, do not use adapters, power strips or extension lead as this may cause overheating and pose a fire hazard.

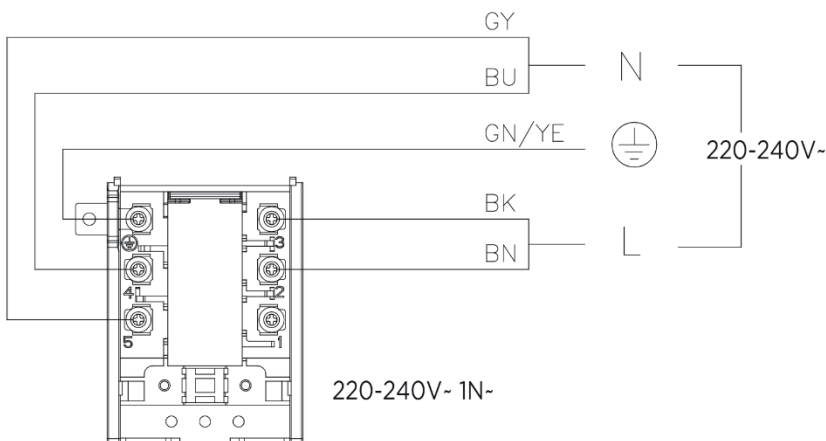
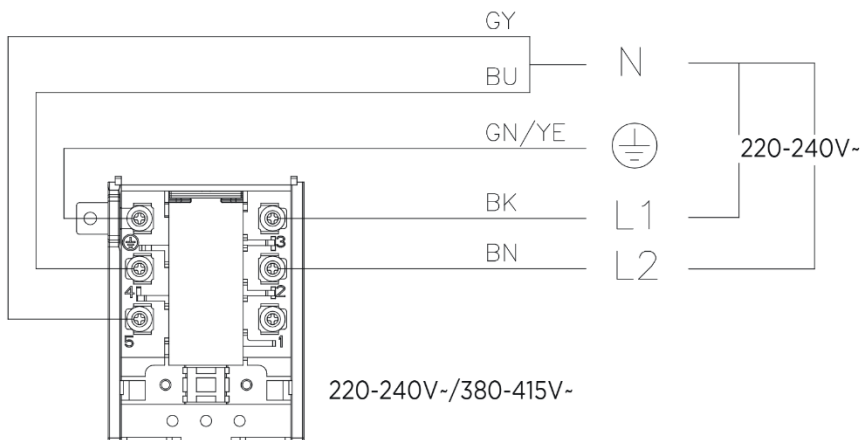
The power supply cable must not come into contact with hot parts and must be positioned so that the temperature does not exceed 75 °C at any time.

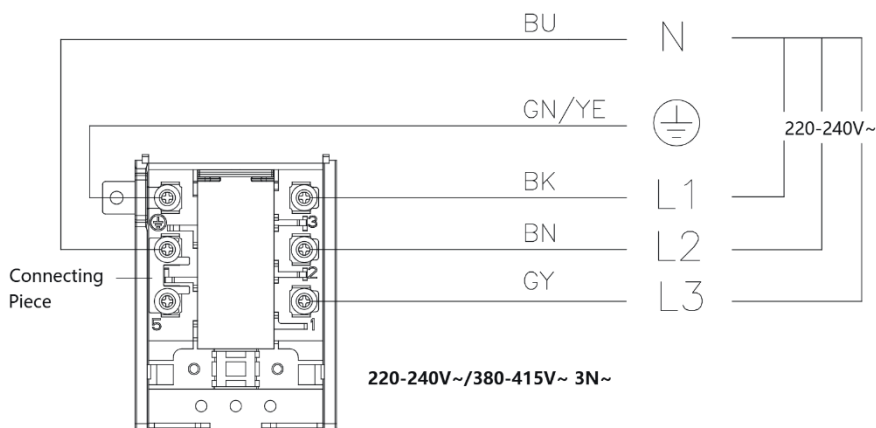
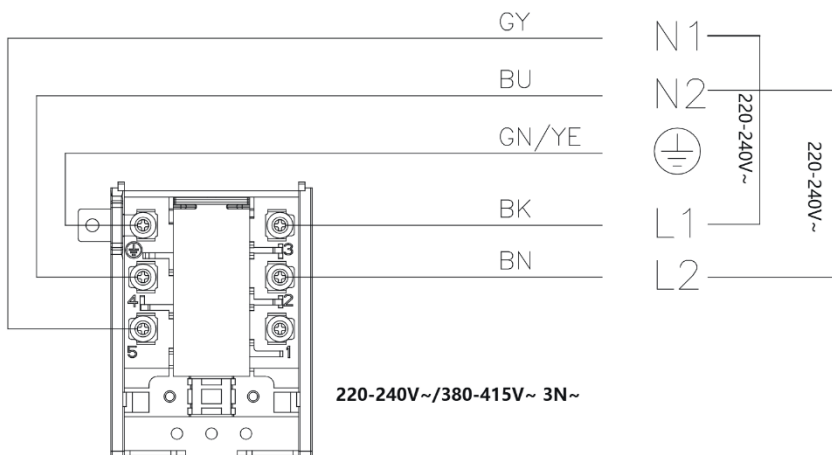


Contact a qualified electrician to assess whether your home's electrical installation is suitable without any modifications. Any modifications must only be carried out by a qualified electrician.

- If the appliance has four or more cooking zones, it can be connected directly to the power supply via a single-phase connection as shown below.
- If the power cable is damaged or needs replacing, this must be carried out by qualified personnel using the correct tools to prevent accidents.
- For direct connection, a multi-pole switch with a contact gap of at least 3 mm must be installed.

- The installer must ensure that the electrical connection has been carried out correctly and complies with the applicable safety regulations.
- Do not bend or pinch the cable.
- The cable must be checked regularly and may only be replaced by authorised professionals.





! Once installed, the underside of the appliance and the power cable must not be accessible.

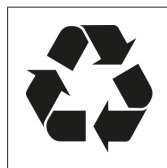
